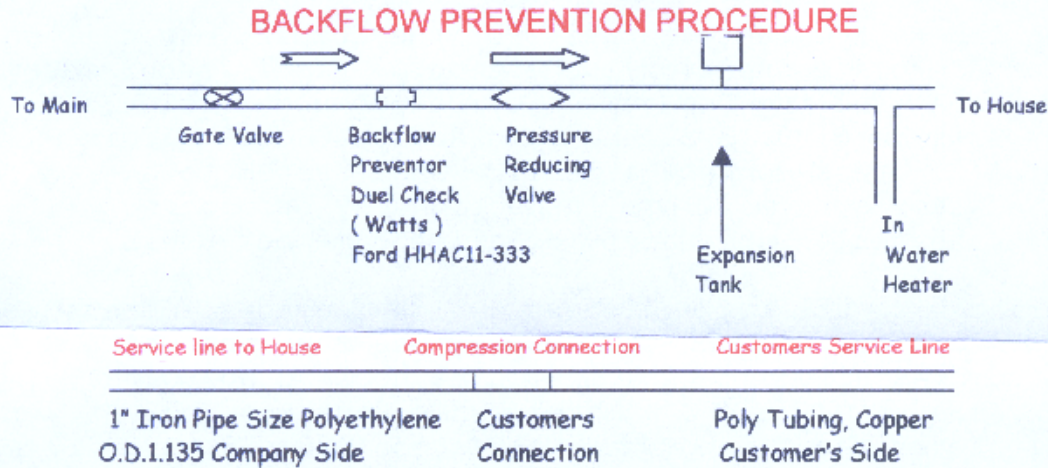
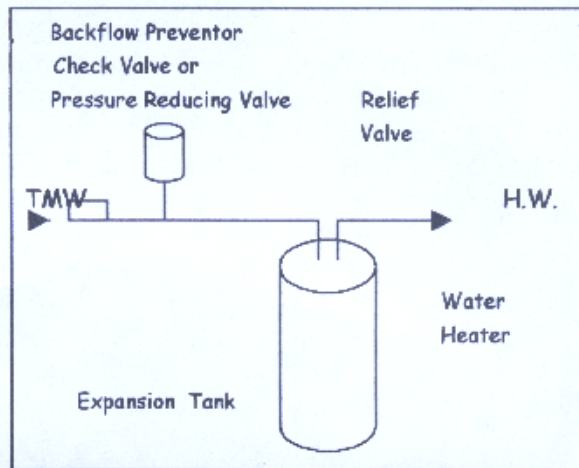

Why the Little Water Tank?

This is the question ask by many Homeowners. The little tank that the Plumber installed in the cold water line, will extend the life of your hot water heater. Water Expands when it is heated. This expanded water previously pushed the water in your cold water line back into the water main. However, with various codes now requiring backflow prevention devises and pressure reducing valves to be installed in the water system, the water can no longer back into the water main. The "Little



Tank" is an expansion tank which acts as a temporary storage site.

This tank also prevents the water heater relief valve from popping off possibly failing when really needed. The expansion tank helps to extend the life expencyancy of other water using appliances by preventing the increase of water pressure.
